FIGURE IV-4 WYOMING GOVERNMENT TRENDS
















FIGURE IV-8 INVESTMENTS BY MAJOR TYPE







FIGURE IV-9 PROJECTED SEVERANCE TAX REVENUES ON VARIOUS MINERALS
